TERMS & CONDITIONS - The Philatelic Auctioneers Standard Terms and Conditions of sale apply, a copy of which is available on request. Placing a bid is your acceptance of these terms. Your statutory rights are not affected.

HOW TO BID - This is a **POSTAL AUCTION** and operates in the same way as any Public Auction except you do not need to attend our premises to take part. Simply enter on the Postal Bidding Form overleaf the maximum amounts you are prepared to pay for as many of the lots you wish to bid on and return it to us in the enclosed pre-paid envelope. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO SIGN THE BID FORM.** We will enter these bids on your behalf and buy at the lowest possible price subject to other bids received and reserves. For example:

On a lot estimated at £100 three bids are received. Buyer "A" bids £80; Buyer "B" £100 and buyer "C" £130. Buyer "C" is successful because his bid is the highest received **but he only pays £110** being one bidding step above the underbidder "B".

Alternatively on a lot estimated £250 only one bid is received from Buyer "A" who bids £275. He is successful because his is the only bid received however, **he only pays £220** because the lot is reserved at this price.

Where bids are received which are equal the first one received will be the successful buyer. For example on a lot estimated £80 three bids are received. Buyer "A" bids £95; Buyer "B" £95 and Buyer "C" £95. Buyer "A" is successful at £95 because his was the first bid received.

Bids can also be made by Telephone, Fax or Email but must be confirmed in writing. **BIDS ARE CONFIDENTIAL** and will not be disclosed to third parties under any circumstances.
